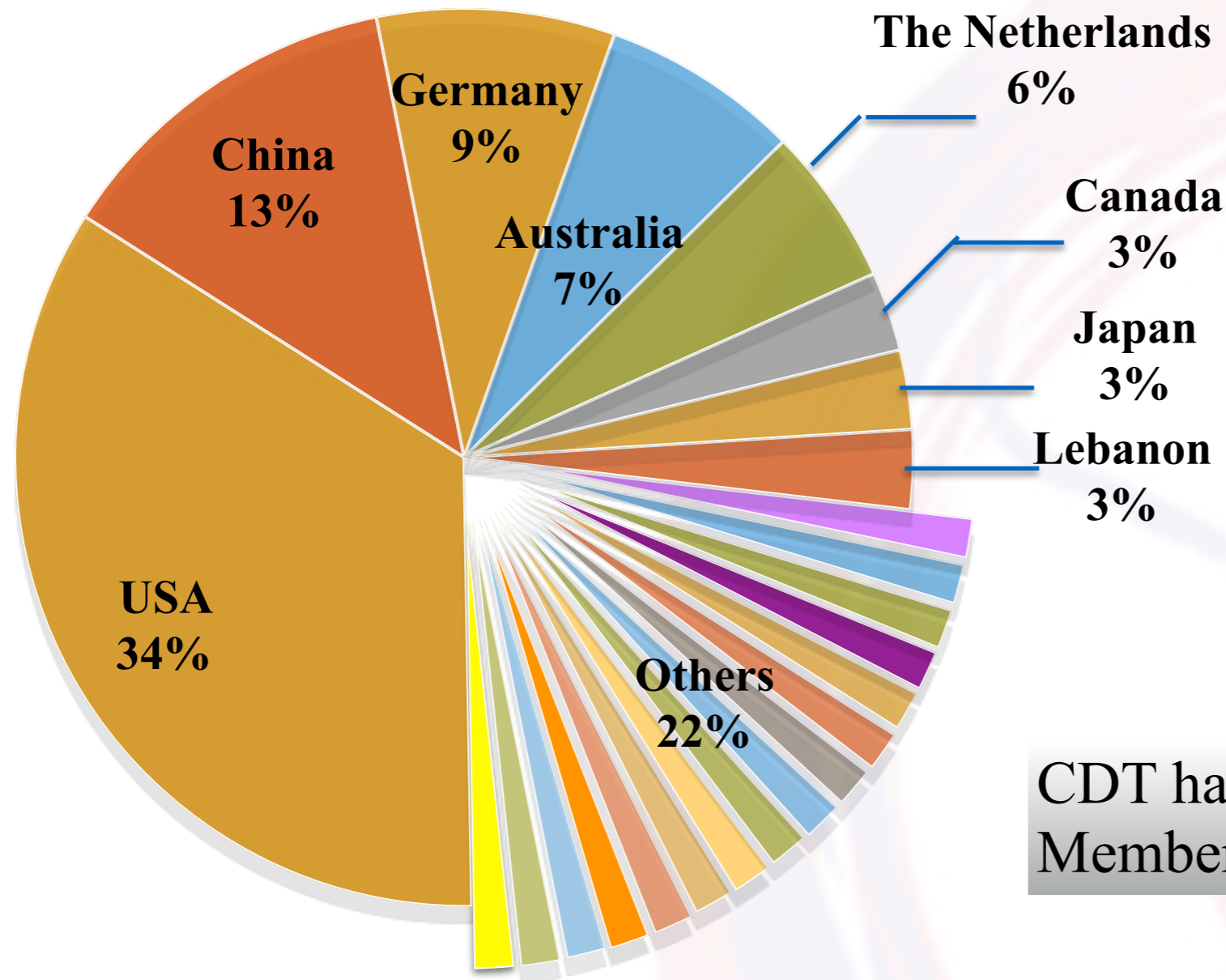

3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

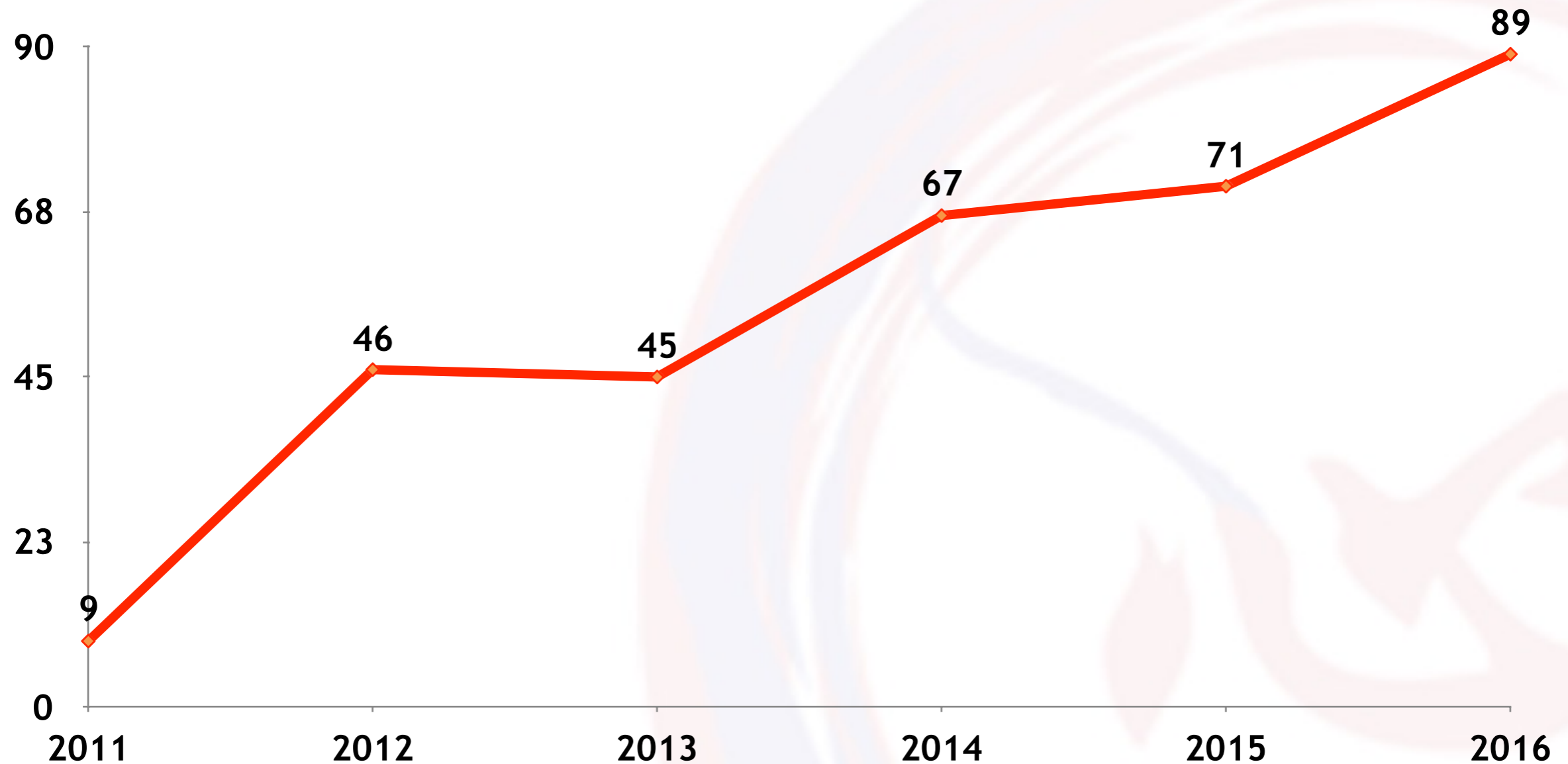


CDT has **70** Editorial Board Members from **24** countries.

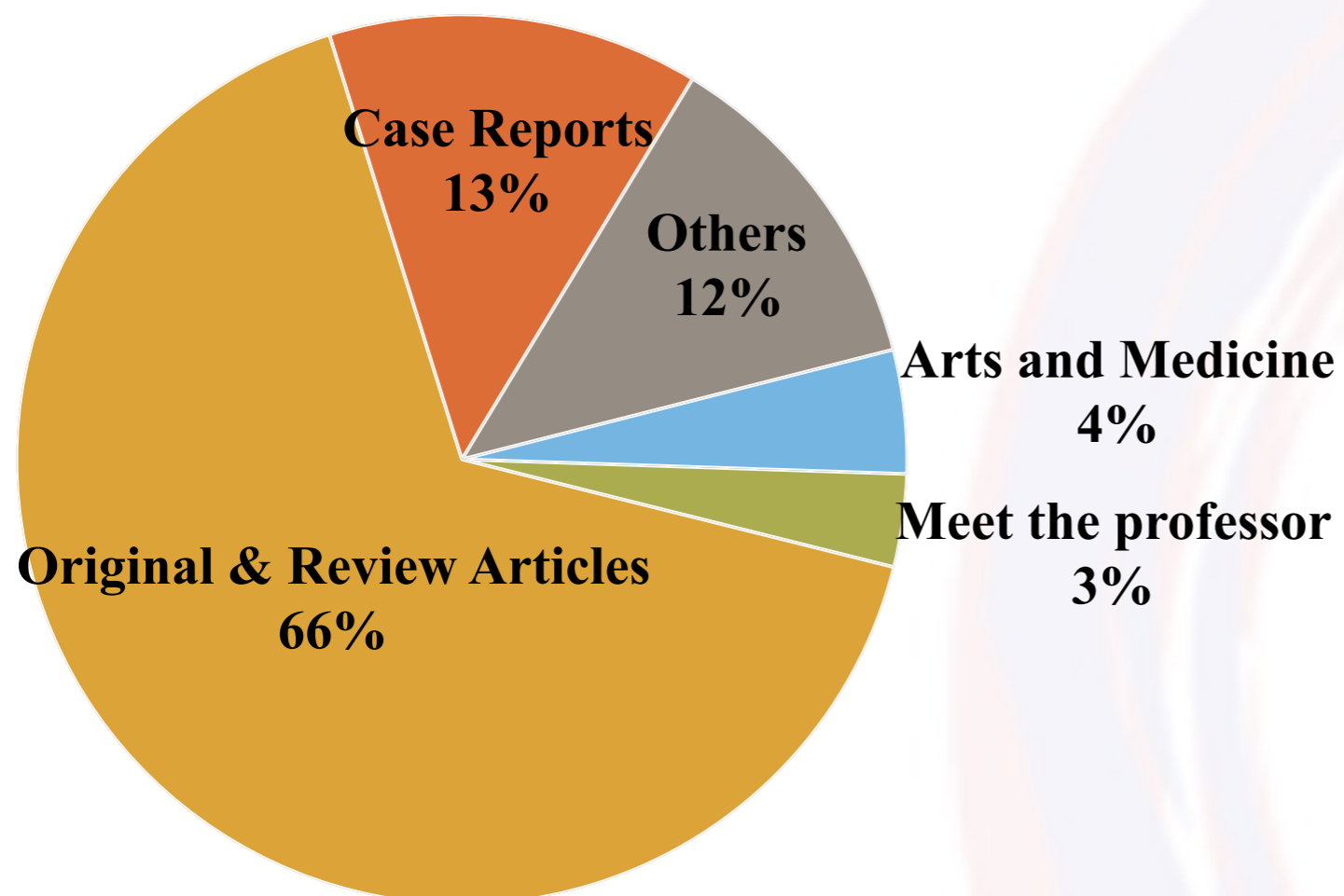
4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

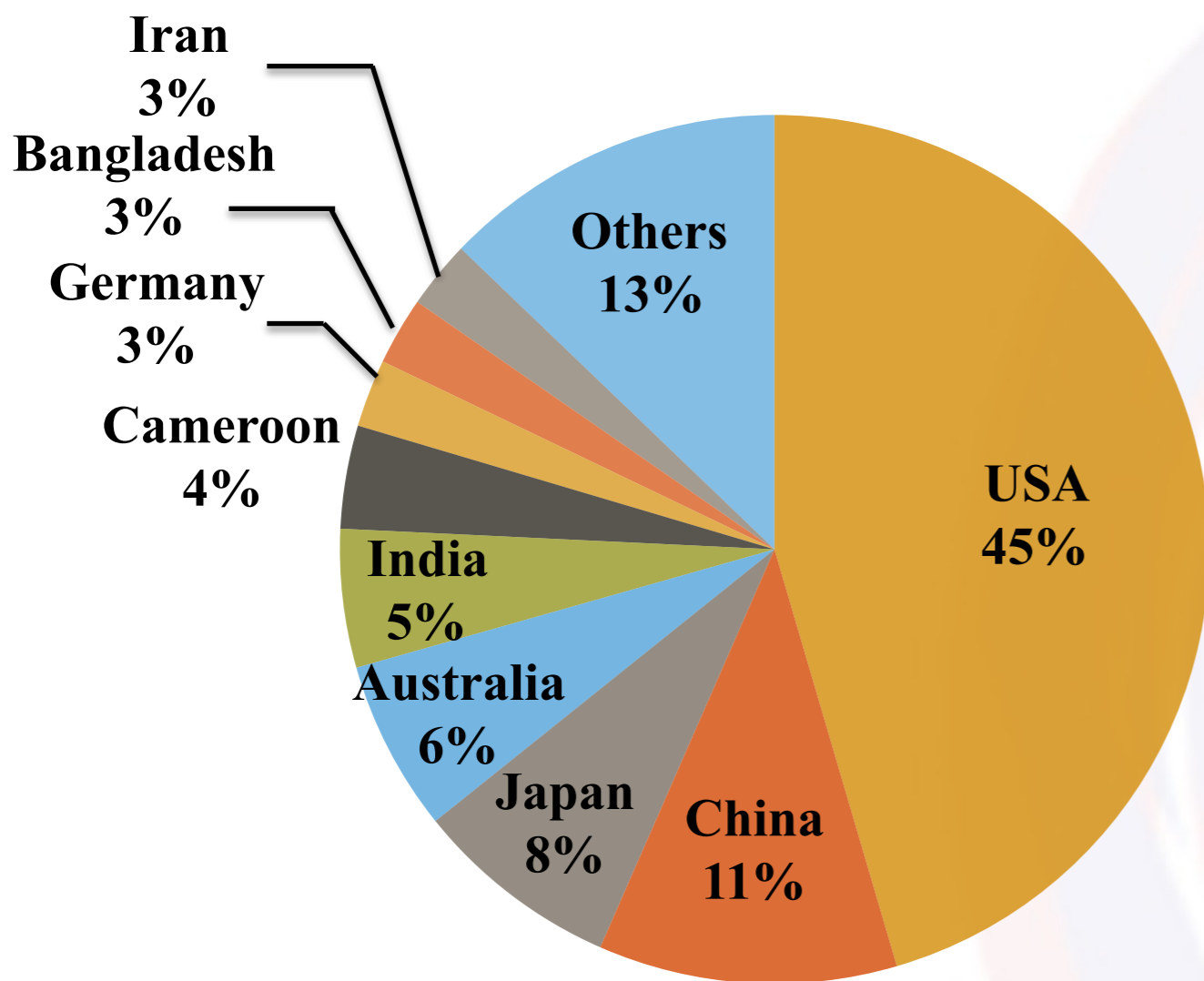
5. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016

6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2016

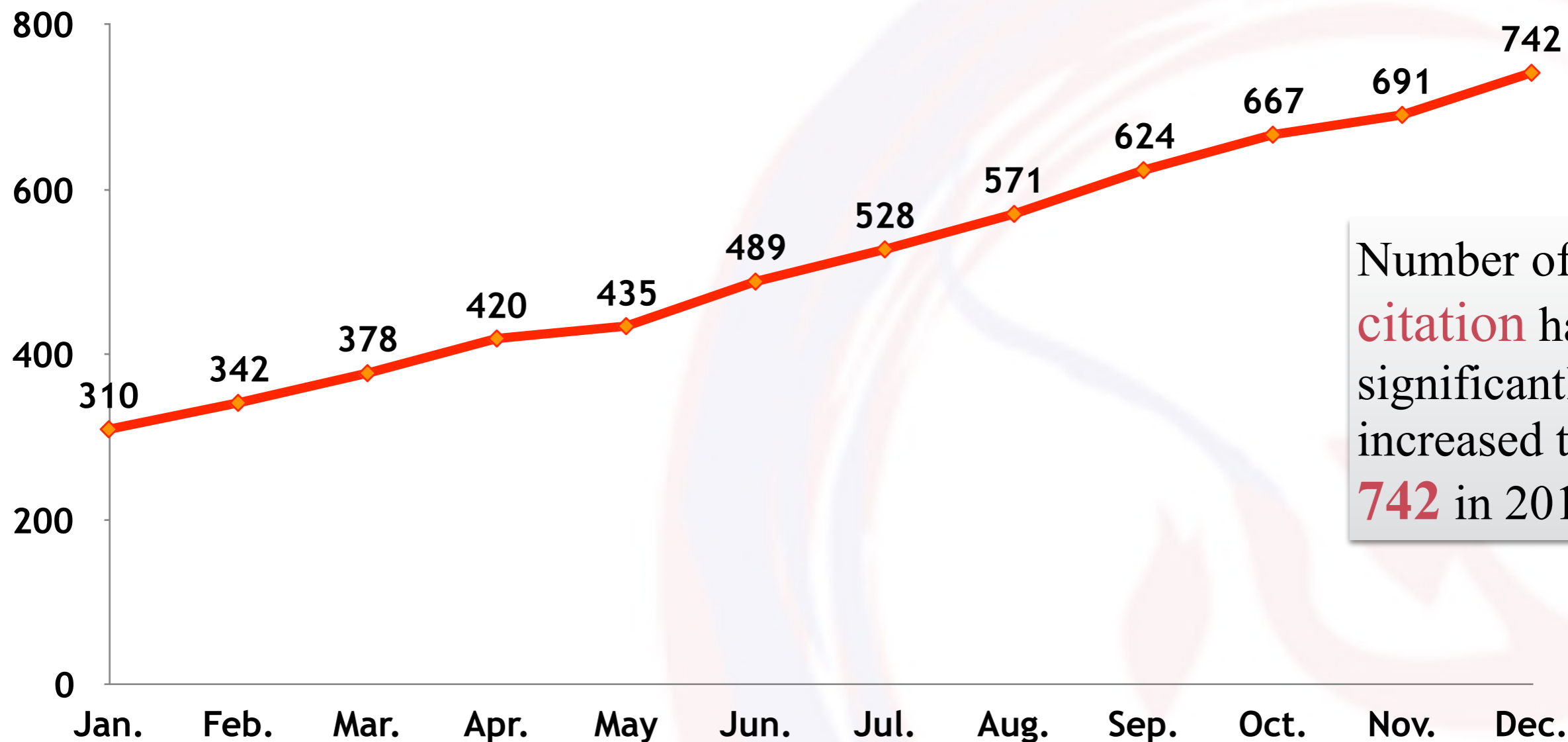


Corresponding authors of 89 articles published in 2016 come from **19 countries** with 45% of them from USA.

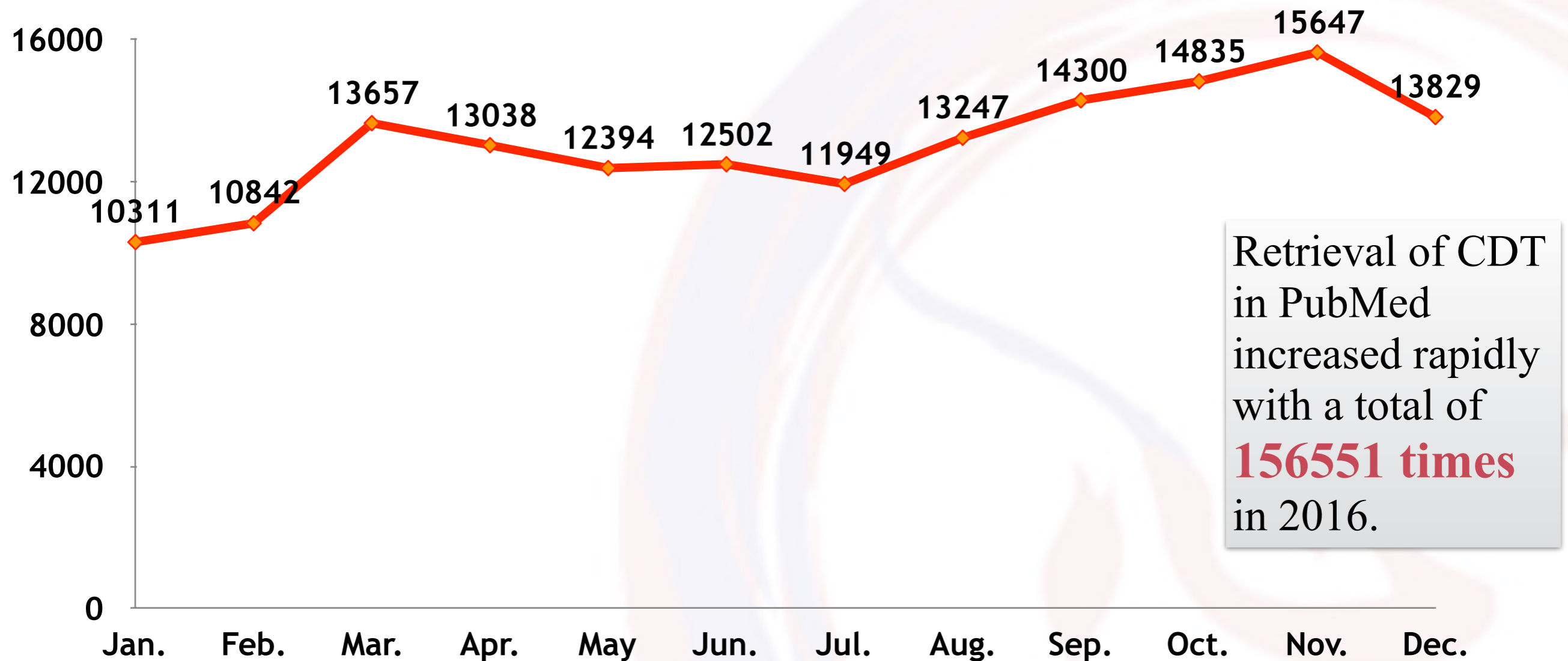

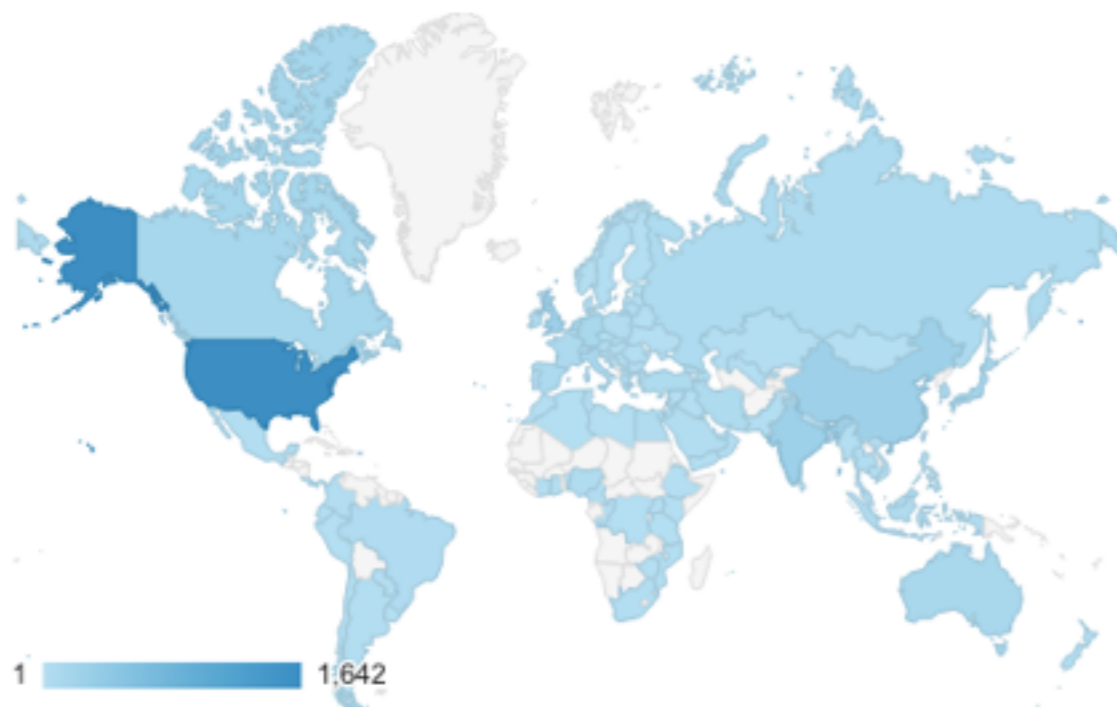
9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2016
